

Heat Stroke – It's No Joke

If you notice any of these signs, seek veterinary care immediately

- ✓ Seizures, dizziness, signs of confusion
- ✓ Excessive, loud panting and drooling
- ✓ Difficulty breathing
- ✓ Vomiting
- ✓ Diarrhea
- ✓ Lethargic, refusing to do anything
- ✓ Staggering or collapsing



WAYS TO AVOID HEAT STROKE

- ✓ AVOID HOT PAVEMENT AND MIDDAY WALKS
- ✓ KEEP PETS INDOORS DURING EXTREME HEAT
- ✓ CREATE A COOL SPOT WITH A POOL OR MAT
- ✓ CHECK THAT SHADE STAYS CONSISTENT AS THE SUN MOVES
- ✓ ALWAYS PROVIDE CLEAN, COOL WATER
- ✓ NEVER LEAVE PETS IN THE CAR
- ✓ ENSURE SHADE FOR REST, FOOD, AND WATER AREAS
