## July 4th Pet Safety Tips:



Create a safe, calm room indoors. Soft music, a fan, and/or a crate can help your pet feel secure and block out noise.



Only go outside on a leash. Check fence line and fence locks.



No food, fireworks, or glow sticks near pets.



Use ID tags, microchips, or simply write phone # on collar.



Exercise earlier in the day.



Keep them away from grills & hot grease.



Keep a recent photo on hand.



*Practice using the safe room  
in advance so it feels familiar.  
Settle pets early on the 4th, as  
fireworks often start before dark and  
continue on days before and after.*
